Emmanuel Home cordially greets you with appreciation for your selection of our Personal Care Home. We have developed the following information to assist you in making your transition from your current residency to our home. We understand that the process can cause some anxiety. We desire to be supportive and provide as much information and services to ease the change.

Prior to Admission

- Evaluate resident to determine proper level of care – A visit to the home or residence will be done prior to admission to determine the proper level of care. The assessment is non-invasive and is only information gathered to determine if Emmanuel Home can meet the needs of the individual. A review of all medications will be done.
- Medical Evaluation – This one-sided form is contained in your Admission packet. It is a state requirement to be completed prior to admission or no more than 30 days after admission. This form is completed by the family practice doctor that will be following your care.
- Support for Veterans or Spouses of Veterans – Emmanuel Home will assist each resident that has Veterans eligibility as necessary. See Emmanuel Home Administrative Assistant for details.

Admission

- Medications and Pharmacy – Each resident can have the pharmacy of their choice. Emmanuel Home will provide support in this area at no extra cost to the resident.
- Admission contract – This will be completed on the day of admission with the resident and designated/POA person.

- Equipped for TV and phone if desired
- Cleaned daily
- We will assist you with picture hanging. We will avoid putting tape on furniture and drilling holes in the doors.

- Diet – we offer a nice selection of meals
- Emmanuel Home provides the daily requirements of fruits, vegetables, and carbohydrates.
- Diabetics – we offer alternative foods to support your control
- Heart Failure – we provide low sodium, low fat meals to support your control

- Special luncheons are held in the activity room for various occasions.

Laundry and Linen

- Laundry is daily and linen is provided and changed weekly
- Emmanuel Home will provide sheets, pillows, blankets and bed spreads. If you have a favorite bed spread, we will wash and clean it.

Phone and TV Services

- At resident's expense if desired

Visitation

- 12 hours daily
- All visitors sign in and out for safety and compliance with regulations
- Resident are requested to sign out and in when returning to let staff know of their whereabouts
- Family may use activity or dining room for special events

Safety and Security

- Emmanuel Home is connected to a 24/hr monitoring system for fire and security
- Emmanuel Home campus is well-lit at night and security systems are armed for resident safety
